We will stop for supper on the way home and the students will need money for that.

THINGS TO BRING LIST

Clothes: Bring comfortable clothes to wear throughout the week. The students need to bring at least one pair of jeans to wear to church. We will wear our mission trip shirts to church on Sunday morning. The students may want to pack a couple sets of extra clothes just in case they get dirty or paint on their clothes one day. Part of how they need to pack will depend on the ministry project they do and as soon as I know exactly what we will be doing I will let you know.

Bedding: Each student will have a bunk bed with a mattress. The students will need to bring sheets or a sleeping bag to put on the mattress. They will also need to bring a pillow.

Toiletries: The place we are staying has individual showers to use but the students will need to bring towel, washcloth, soap, toothbrush, etc. I would recommend sandals or flip flops for the showers also.

Money: The \$250 covers lodging, meals while we are there, mission trip shirt, and entrance into the zoo. The students need to bring money for one fast food meal on the way there and one fast food meal on the way home. We will also periodically stop at a gas station and if the students want to buy a snack or a soda they are welcome to do that.

Electronic Devices: Students are welcome to bring handheld gaming devices to play in the car on the way to Omaha and on the way home. Once we arrive we will ask them to put them away and not get them out until we begin the trip home.

Phone: There will be some down time each day for the students to call home. I want the students to talk to you each day and I will encourage them to do so. I am also fine with students using their phones to take pictures. But we all know that phones can easily become a distraction or a way for students to disconnect from the group and do their own thing. So I will encourage students to call home, but I will also ask them put their phones away if they are are using them for any other reason than talking to you or taking pictures.
